## Calendar Year (CY) 2022 Medicare Physician Fee Schedule Proposed Rule

## August 2021

In July 2021, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) released a proposed rule that announced proposed policy and practice changes for Medicare Part B payments beginning January 1, 2022. The proposed changes may impact the work and reimbursement of social workers in various settings and that of other Medicare providers.
